Weather permitting (Michigan covered in clouds 66% of the time), we will be able to see 98.98% of the eclipse. For eye safety, special eclipse glasses must be worn. We found them at Menard's for \$2 a pair. Never look at the sun without special glasses. Permanent damage to eyes can happen. We will not have another eclipse like this over North America for 20 years.
